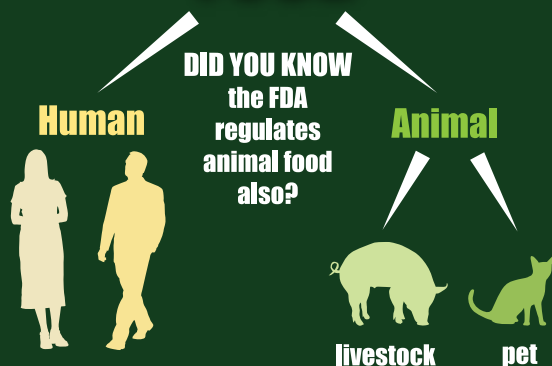

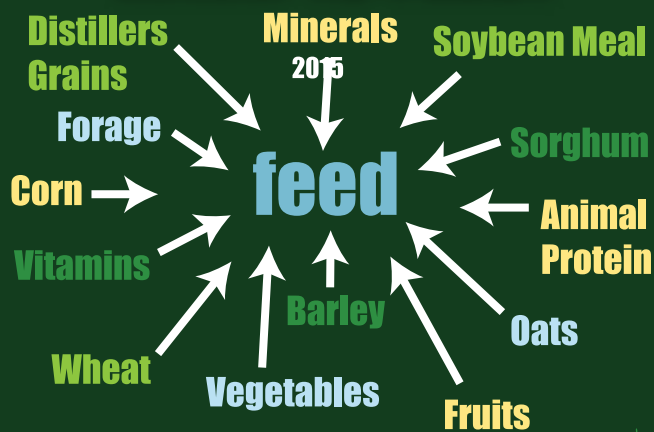


**Do you consume milk, meat or eggs?**

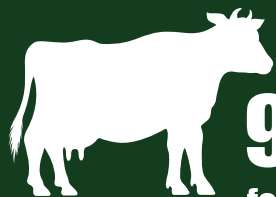
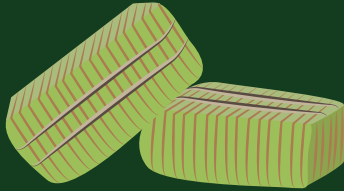

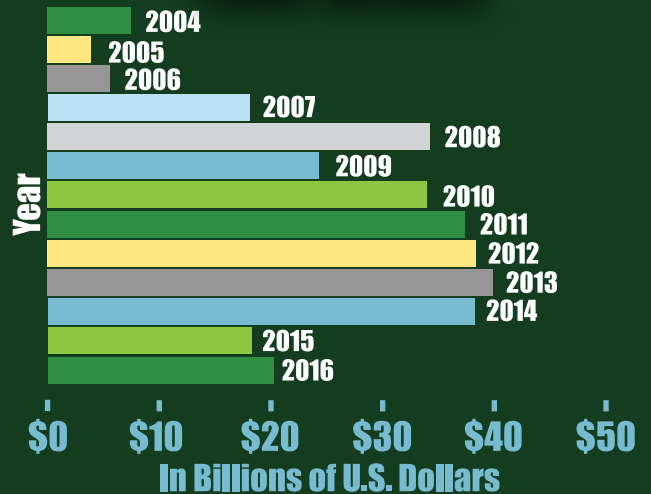

### Sustainability in Feed:



Partnering with state regulators, AFIA identified co-products (from fruits, vegetables, nuts, juices, distillers, meats, etc.) that can safely be used in animal food. Ongoing diet research is finding ways to further reduce feed's environmental footprint. By reducing and reusing, the feed industry helps provide sustainable human nutrition. Efficient animals can help feed a growing population. Cows, for example, can turn human-inedible grass into very nutritious milk.

**FACT:** In the U.S., less than 3% of all greenhouse gas emissions can be attributed to livestock production.

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
